Academic Standing:

Good Standing	A cumulative grade point average of 2.00 or higher Exception for schools of Skilled Trades & Emergency Services – a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or higher
Academic Warning	Students whose cumulative grade point average falls between 1.50 and 1.99 Exception for the School of Health - grade point average between 1.80 and 1.99
Probation	Students whose cumulative grade point average falls between 1.00 and 1.49 Exception for the School of Health - grade point average between 1.50 and 1.79 Exception for schools of Skilled Trades & Emergency Services – a cumulative GPA between 2.00 and 2.99
Suspension	Students whose cumulative grade point average is less than 0.99 Exception for the School of Health – cumulative grade point average is less than 1.49 Exception for schools of Skilled Trades & Emergency Services – a cumulative GPA less than 1.99

PRE 1994

A minimum of D (50%) in each subject with an overall average of 60% or better is required to graduate.

AFTER 1994

A minimum of D (50%) in each subject with a cumulative GPA of 2.00 or better is required to graduate.

Schools of Skilled Trades & Emergency Services

A minimum of B (70%) in each subject with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 is required to graduate.

Note: However one subject only with a grade of C (60-69%) is permitted throughout the program.

Repeated Courses

Students may repeat courses in which they receive a failing grade. Only the highest grade is used in calculating the grade point average (GPA). Repeated courses are denoted as follows:

I	Mark is included in GPA
E	Mark is excluded from GPA

Course Numbering

Courses are designated by a three or four character subject code and a three to five character course identifier. The first four characters of the course identifier are numeric. If present the fifth character is a U to indicate an undergraduate University course, taken in collaboration with the University of Ontario Institute of Technology.
